2024 Classes

- DORSET** Class 1 Ram under 1½ years woolly any wool length.
- HORNS** Class 2 Milk tooth ram any wool length, born on or after 1st August 2023.
- Class 3 Ram lamb dropped on or after 1st April 2024.
- Champion Ram**
- Reserve Champion Ram**
- Class 4 Ewe under 1½ years, any wool length.
- Class 5 Milk tooth ewe any length wool, born on or after 1st August 2023.
- Class 6 Ewe lamb born after 1st April 2024.
- Champion Ewe**
- Reserve Champion Ewe**
- Class 7 Group of 1 ram and 2 ewes under 1 ½ years – any wool length.

- SCHOOLS** Class 8 1 ram, up to 2cm wool, under 1 1/2 years.
- Class 9 Pair rams, up to 2cm wool, under 1 1/2 years.
- Class 10 Ewe over 1 ½ years shorn suckling her own offspring.
- Class 11 1 ewe, up to 2cm wool, under 1 1/2 years.
- Class 12 Pair ewes, up to 2cm wool, under 1 1/2 years.

****All school classes open to Poll Dorsets and Dorset Horns.

The winner from each schools' class is eligible to exhibit in the equivalent open class.

Schools are may also enter open classes, but the same sheep cannot be entered in both the schools classes and open classes.

Sheep can be entered into one class only.

Novice Rams

Class 13 **The Lindsay Wright Memorial Class (CW NSW Region)** Novice ram under 1½ years shorn (open to Horns) *to be prepared and handled by exhibitors.*

Senior Rams

Class 14 Restricted Class: Ram under 1 ½ years shorn. Not more than 2cm wool. To be eligible studs must have no more than 100 ewes.

Class 15 Lambplan Class: Ram under 1 ½ years, shorn.

Born on or after 1st April in the year prior to the Show.

Notify Roger Traves of entry tag numbers, no later than 1st June.

Lambplan Assessment:

TCP Index the difference between the highest and lowest index will be doubled and allocated to the judge for selective judging points. These points will be added to the individual entrant's index to give a total score.

Class 16 Performance ram under 1½ years old, born on or after 1st April 2023. Machine shorn not more than 28 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.

Class 17 **Brien Freebairn Memorial Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old woolly

Class 18 **Gererdan Trophy Ram** under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool

Class 19 **Balmoral Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days prior to judging. (OM)

The trophy was presented by WS Martin & Son and an investment is held by the NSW State Committee. The trophy to the value of the accrued interest shall be awarded to the exhibitor who gains first in the class on three occasions, not necessarily in succession, after which it shall recommence.

Class 20 Pair rams under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool

Intermediate Rams

Class 21 Performance Ram - Milk tooth, born on or after 1st June 2023. Machine shorn, not more than 28 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.

Class 22 Ram born on or after 1st June 2023, Milk tooth shorn, not more than 2 cm wool.

Class 23 Ram, born on or after 1st June 2023 Milk Tooth. Machine shorn not more than 28 days prior to judging.

Class 24 Pair of rams, born on or after 1st June 2023, Milk Tooth not more than 2cm wool.

Junior / Spring Drop Rams

- Class 25 Performance ram – Milk tooth, born on or after 1st August 2023, Machine shorn not more than 28 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.
- Class 26 Ram woolly born on or after 1st August 2023.
- Class 27 Ram, shorn, not more than 2 cm wool and born on or after 1st August.2023.
- Class 28 Pair of rams, shorn, no more than 2 cm wool and born on or after 1st August 2023.
- Class 29 Ram lamb born on or after 1st April 2024.

- Class 33 Ewe under 1½ years woolly.
- Class 34 **Springwaters Trophy** Ewe under 1½ years shorn, not more than 2 cm wool.
- Class 35 Ewe under 1½ years, machine shorn not more than 28 days prior to judging.
- Class 36 Pair ewes under 1½ years, shorn, not more than 2 cm wool.
- Class 37 Milk tooth ewe, shorn, not more than 2 cm, born after 1st August 2023.
- Class 38 **Claremont Trophy** Ewe lamb dropped on or after 1st April 2024.
